

„Der rote Faden“ – Ausstellung im Barmbek°Basch

The exhibition “**The Red Thread**” presents the results of the creative art project of the same name.

From 28.08. – 27.09.2024, weekdays from 9 am – 7 pm

Despite the weather, around 20 participants - including parents, children and senior citizens - came together in mid-July to explore Barmbek-Süd and test their artistic capacities. Equipped with red thread, chalk and full of creative ideas, they set off to transform places and objects into surprising works of art. They captured the resulting installations in photographs. For three hours, the district was a playground for creative minds. The participants were given between 30 and 60 minutes to realize their ideas and integrate them into an overall artistic concept. The results were then presented at a joint picnic. The creative exchange and enthusiasm among the participants quickly led to the idea of an exhibition of the more than 30 resulting photographs, which is now being realized.

The participation of the **Sträkelclub** of the Alt Barmbek parish, which was also actively involved in the preparations for the exhibition, deserves special mention. The members made backgrounds from red wool especially for the exhibition, giving the photographs a special frame. In autumn, these woolen works will be processed into scarves and donated to the needy (food distribution of the Frohbotschaftskirche and Klaras Küche, St. Franziskus).
